



Year 5 Summer Term 2022

English

As writers, we will be exploring texts that inform the reader and applying the skills we find to a biography that we will be writing. We will focus on the structure to make the information clear to our reader.

Maths

In maths, we will be starting our new topic on fractions where we will develop and build on our previous skills. We will begin by looking at equivalent fractions.

Relationships and Health Education

In RHE, we will be recapping the emotional and physical changes that occur during puberty, including reproductive organs and external genitalia. Key vocabulary – menstruation, puberty, hormones.

RE

In RE, we will be focusing on the Gospel texts from the bible. We will be identifying similarities between what Jesus would do and our own foundations for living.

Geography

As geographers, the children will describe the location and features of climate zones, biomes and vegetation belts.

PE

In PE this half term, we will be taking part in a sequence of swimming lessons where we will increase our confidence and ability to stay safe in and around water.

Science

In science, the children will be looking at a range of different animals and their habitats. This will include looking at life cycles and plant reproduction.

Art

As artists, we will be exploring typography using our focus artist, Paul Thurlby, as inspiration. We will create our own unique letters in 3D form.

Modern Foreign Languages (MFL)

This term, the children will be learning how to interact with one another in Spanish. They will be learning about the different seasons of the year as well as learning about modes of transport.

Music

Excitedly, the children will be learning the song lyrics to the well-known song 'Lean on me'. They will be recreating the song using tambourines and rattles.
