Dear Parents,

Please can I start by reminding you to make sure your child has wet wipes in their bag if they are in nappies/pullups. And please can all items like bags and bottles be labelled with your child's name.

This week we have continued the Easter theme looking at things that hatch from eggs as the children loved this. Also we have been talking about new life that we see in spring time on farms. We have looked at baby animals like lambs, bunnies, and ducklings.

We have been using a pom-pom reward system the last two weeks, where we catch the children being good and they can pop a pom-pom in the jar and at the end of the session we count them up. Today was a record 24 pompoms! This is working well as the children feel happy they have been noticed for making the right choices and not just when they haven't.

The sound of the week is 'r' and the oral blending continues. Also to help the understanding of sounds we have been using nonsense rhymes, so if your child calls you mummy lummy or such like you know why! Any questions please feel free to ask any of the team.
