



Year 4 Summer Term 2022

English

This term, the children will be writing to inform the reader. We are going to be writing an explanation about the digestive system using the new Jane Considine approach that we started last half term.

Maths

In maths, we will be learning about decimals, focusing on tenths and hundredths. We will also be linking decimals to our fractions learning that we did last term.

Relationships and Health Education

In RHE this term, we will start by looking at our physical health and mental wellbeing. We will then move on to a topic called 'Keeping Safe'. This will focus on using medicines safely and the effects of other legal drugs (smoking, alcohol, and caffeine). We will do this in an age appropriate and sensitive way that the children can understand.

RE

In RE, we will be exploring Christianity and the story of the Pentecost. The children will be looking at Bible scripture and images to support their learning.

Geography

As geographers, we will be discovering how mountains and rivers are formed and researching some amazing physical landmarks around the world.

PE

In PE, we will be doing a range of athletic activities getting ready for sports day later in the term. The children will work on their teamwork and communication skills throughout this.

Science

As scientists, the children will be learning about the human body. We will focus on the digestive system and teeth with lots of exciting experiments!

Art

As artists, we will be creating sculptures. We will look at the work of Laura Ford and create our own animal sculpture out of Modroc.

Modern Foreign Languages (MFL)

In Spanish, we will be revising basic greetings and learning how to talk about our age and nationality.

Music

In music, we will be listening to and recognising soul and gospel music and using the glockenspiels to accompany a song by Bill Withers. Next half term, we will be looking at songs by the Beatles using the recorders.
