



## Year 1 Summer Term 2022

### English

Year 1 will be writing to inform with a focus on the key skills of basic sentence structure and punctuation. We will be linking our learning to Geography with a focused outcome of writing a letter to a traveller.

### Maths

As mathematicians we will be exploring the place value of numbers within 50. This will involve counting forwards and backwards, identifying tens and ones as well as comparing and ordering. Alongside this we will be mastering counting in 2s, 5s and 10s.

### Relationships and Health Education

We will be focusing on our physical and mental wellbeing – how we can keep ourselves healthy physically and mentally. Keywords we are using: hygiene, routine, exercise, unhealthy and healthy emotions.

### RE

Year 1 will be looking at Creation in R.E. this term. We will be thinking about the sequence of creation, why Sunday is a day of rest and why Christians give thanks to God.

### Geography

As Geographers, we are going to be discovering hot and cold countries of the world and how the Equator affects climates. We will be reading maps, learning how to locate hot and cold countries and looking at the physical features of the different areas.

### PE

In PE, we will master basic movements including running, jumping, throwing and catching, as well as developing balance, agility and coordination, and begin to apply these in a range of activities .

### Science

As scientists we are going to be continuing to observe our seasons. We will be investigating how they affects the hours of sunlight we have and the different weather types.

### Art

As artists we will be looking at the works of Antoni Gaudi and sculpture. We will be designing our very own sculptures linking with nature.

### Modern Foreign Languages (MFL)

The children will be focusing on zoo animals. They will learn Spanish names of animals, and combining this with their knowledge of colours, they are going to create a short story .

### Music

As musicians the children will be using their imagination, listening to and appraising music, as well as learning the song of Your Imagination by Joana Mangona and Pete Readman.
