



Questions and answers! Summer Fayre 5th July 2019

- **Start time** - 2pm
- **Finish time** 4pm
- **Do I have to stay the 2 hours?** No you are free to leave whenever you like. The Choir will be performing at 2pm the Samba at 3pm
- **Where will I collect my child at 2pm?** All children will be dismissed from the main playground
- **Where will my child be if I cannot collect at 2pm** - All children will remain with staff in the Year 6 block until you can collect at 3pm
- **Can my child go around the fayre alone?** - For the safety of all children they must be accompanied by an adult (over the age of 18).
- **Can a friend or other family member take them around the fayre?** - Yes, as long as the teacher has it in writing.
- **Is it school uniform on the fayre day?** - Yes uniform as usual.
- **Is there an entrance fee?** No all stalls are individually priced.
- **Will there be refreshments?** - PTFA will be doing their pop up coffee shop, this includes tea, coffee hot dogs and cakes. There is also a candy floss stall this year
- **How much will the stalls cost?** Stalls will be priced between 50p and £1.
- **What happens to the money raised?** All money goes to the PTFA who then use this money to fund school trips and visits, provide the school with equipment, arrange events for the children and much more.
- **What time is the raffle drawn?** The raffle will be drawn at 3:30pm in the playground
- **What will happen to my raffle prize if I am not there to collect it?** All prizes will be kept by the PTFA who will then phone you in the coming few days to arrange collection of the prize.
