English

Year 5 will begin by recapping previous taught sentence structures. The children will develop their use of precise vocabulary, as well as, using a range of skills to develop their writing to form more complex sentences in order to write a variety of texts to inform.

Maths

In maths this term, year 5 will be getting to grips with numbers up to 1,000,000. Children will use their place value knowledge to help them to add and subtract large numbers and apply this skill to word problems.

Relationships and Health Education

In RHE, we will be focusing on 'Safe Relationships' and the importance of understanding the boundaries within friendships and what is acceptable and unacceptable in regards to physical contact.

Key vocabulary – permission, acceptable, unacceptable, comfortable.

RE

Year 5 will begin by focusing on Christianity and what Christians believe about God. In the second half of the Autumn term children will look at Incarnation and the Messiah through stories

History

As Historians, the children will be exploring the impact of the Viking invasion on England through the use of historical sources of evidence and its reliability.

PE

In PE, year 5 will be continuing develop the skills required for invasion games, such as, defending and attacking. The children will practise these skills through netball and basketball.

SCIENCE

Year 5 will be exploring materials and their properties. They will continue to develop their skills at working scientifically by planning experiments, recognising variables and reporting the data.
