



YEAR 2 AUTUMN TERM 2021

English

Year 2 will be writing to entertain using “My Lighthouse Keeper’s Lunch” by Ronda Armitage to support their learning. The children will be creating setting descriptions and retelling the story.

Maths

In maths this term, year 2 will be learning about numbers and place value. Counting to and from 100, and counting in different steps of 2, 5 and 10. Including writing numbers to twenty.

Relationships and Health Education

This term in RHE, the children will be learning about respectful relationships. This includes what friendship looks like and what makes a good friend. Key vocab includes consent, bullying, trusted adults, keeping safe

RE

We will be exploring Christianity, particularly focusing on how Christians see God as being loving, kind, fair and forgiving. This will be done through Bible stories.

Geography

As Geographers, we are going to be looking at the countries and capitals that make up the United Kingdom; including being able to find Torquay on a map.

PE

In PE, year 2 will be focusing on the fundamental skills such as throwing and catching; this will be done through team building games.

Science

This term we will be learning about materials and comparing them. Including looking at how some materials may change shape by squashing, bending and stretching.

D&T

In D&T we will be talking about simple machines and vehicles and how they work. We will then create a car using plastic plates, straws and paint. Before evaluating our car and how well it works.

Modern Foreign Languages (MFL)

In Spanish, the children will learn to speak basic greetings and talk about their feelings, learn to say the colours and the days of the week, months of the year and the seasons.

Music

In Music, we will be listening to South African music and starting to learn to play the glockenspiel as accompaniment to a song. We will be listening and identifying different instruments.
