This week we have had a few more new starters, so I would like to say welcome to those children.

We are continuing the theme of people that help us and looking at doctors. We have watched some videos about doctors and nurses and what they do to help us. The children have had new doctor and nurse dressing up clothes and a full doctors kit to use in the role play area. The children were given the chance to use real bandages too.

There are writing opportunities in the role play area too with appointment cards and prescriptions to complete!
