

Teacher Strikes

All parents will need to consider that teachers reserve the right to change their mind and may decide to tell us on the morning of the strike. I would urge you to have a plan for the proposed strike days in the event of your child's teacher exercising their right to inform us of strike action on the day, rather than in advance. We will text you by 8am on the morning of the strike if your child's class is affected but I would suggest that you make alternative arrangements as a precaution.

- 16 March (whole country strike)






World Book Day 2023


