



# Year 2 Spring Term 2023

## English

As writers, we will be looking at informative and entertaining texts and what key skills are used for each type of writing. We will be focusing on ensuring that sentences have been written grammatically correctly and teaching the key skills of conjunctions and sentence types.

## Maths

As mathematicians, we will be focusing on multiplication and division. Building upon our previous learning to answer problem solving and reasoning questions. We will then be moving onto a block based on money – identifying pounds and pence and what these look like.

## Relationships and Health Education

In RHE, we will be focusing on belonging to a community. We will be looking closely at what this means and the children will be thinking about their role in the community and the value that this has for them. Key vocabulary – belonging, community, safe, teams, inclusion, roles, respect.

## RE

In RE, we will be learning about Christianity. We will explore what Christians believe God is like using a variety of parables from the bible to support this. As we move closer to Easter this will be our focus and why it is important to Christians.

## Geography

As geographers, we will be using basic vocabulary to refer to the key physical features of a river. We will focus on the River Lemon for this as a case study to explain in detail.

## History

As historians, we will be exploring our key question of What happened to London during the fire of 1666? We will be having a visit from the National Archives to share some sources with us in more detail.

## PE

In PE, we will be completing a block of learning on gymnastics and dance. This will support the children to develop their balance and stability within our lessons.

## Science

As scientists, we will be learning about animals. We will focus specifically on their lifecycles and how they grow and develop as well as the habitats that they live in and how they have adapted to these areas.

## Art

As artists this term, we will be developing our knowledge of primary and secondary colours. We will be using the work of Eric Carle to inspire our designs using shapes and colour to help us.

## Modern Foreign Languages (MFL)

In Spanish, we will be learning about the world around me; this will include different body parts in humans and animals; emotions and linking this to a Carnival which is a festival celebrated in February in Spain.

## Music

As musicians, we will be learning to experiment with, create, select and combine a number of sounds to form their own band. As we move into spring 2 we will be using our voice expressively to sing songs.
