

Year 5 Spring Term 2024

English

This term, we will be writing to persuade. We will write a persuasive speech about refugees. We have been learning about what a refugee is and using persuasive techniques to create emotion with the reader. After this, we will be writing to entertain the reader.

Maths

In maths, we will be continuing our learning about fractions. We will be adding and subtracting fractions with different denominators and then multiplying fractions. After this, we will be moving on to decimals and percentages.

Relationships and Health Education

We will be thinking about belonging to a community. We will be looking at vocabulary such as environment, sustainable and responsibility. The children will think about heir local communities as well as belonging to a wider global community.

RE

In RE, we will be discussing our key question: what does it mean to be a Muslim in Britain today? We explore the 5 Pillars of Islam and learn some key vocabulary to aid our understanding.

Geography

As Geographers, we will be learning about hemispheres and time zones. We will learn how to locate the Equator, Northern and Southern Hemisphere, the Tropics of Cancer and Capricorn Arctic and Antarctic Circle and time zones.

History

As Historians, we will be thinking about our key question: how successful was the Viking invasion? We will address any pre-conceptions the children may have about the Vikings and see if there any surprises as to how they really lived. We also make inferences about the past from primary and secondary sources.

PΕ

In PE this term, we will be swimming and tennis. In swimming, the children will be developing what they can already do and learning new skills with this.

Science

As Scientists, we will be learning about all things space. We will start by learning about the planets and then move onto lunar cycle. The children will create detailed drawings with labels and fun experiments.

Art

As artists, we will be exploring colour through painting using our focus artist, Frida Kahlo. We will be developing our portrait skills but with added colour mixing and painting techniques.

Modern Foreign Languages (MFL)

As Linguists, the children will be learning about the different body parts on humans and animals before moving onto looking at emotions and then Carnival as a festival.

Music

Focusing on the music of Adele, the children will recognise styles, find the pulse, recognise instruments, listen and discuss other dimensions of music. They will then work together in a group and perform to each other and an audience.

Computing

As users of technology, we will be programming physical computers to create a motorised sculpture.
