

Ellacombe C of E Academy: 2023-2024 Pupil Outcomes

Below are the school's published outcomes for the end of the academic year 2023-2024. For Key Stage 2, we have also added the Pupil Premium which are the outcomes for those children who are entitled to Free School Meals; it is important that this data is looked at so that we are ensuring all our pupils are achieving the highest possible outcomes.

What this tells us:

We know at Ellacombe that some of our children start in Reception a little bit behind their peers nationally. We work incredibly hard to enable them to swiftly catch-up in all areas of their learning so they are ready to access the Key Stage One curriculum. Investing in our Little Stars Nursery provision means we are able to work even more effectively with our youngest pupils and their parents/carers from the age of 2.

What this tells us:

The school invests heavily with teaching our youngest pupils to read and we know how much our parents/carers help with this through reading with your children at home. We use a very targeted programme to ensure all children are learning all their sounds and any gaps are swiftly filled through interventions.

From this website, it can be seen that our excellent KS2 Outcomes last year meant our school was:

- 17th out of 1783 C of E Academies across the country for % of disadvantaged pupils getting higher standard in R, W and Maths.
- Joint 275 out of 20940 primary schools across the country for overall performance of disadvantaged pupils.
- 2 out of 36 Primary Schools in Torbay for overall performance of disadvantaged pupils.

What this tells us:

By the end of KS2, our pupils achieved above the National Average in all subjects; this is for 'all pupils' and those pupils who are entitled to Pupil Premium funding.

In some areas this was significantly above the National Average and this is a reflection of the highest expectations we have for all our pupils, regardless of their background or starting points.

Even though at Ellacombe we have a number of children who start at the school 'mid-phase' and some children who start school with limited English, all children are making excellent progress with their learning.
