



Year 4 Spring Term 2025

English

This term, we will be focusing on writing to inform. The children will be writing a newspaper article informing people about the use of social media for under 13-year-olds. Within this, the children will learn key skills including the use of quotations and data.

Maths

As mathematicians, the children will learn methods of multiplying and dividing. They will develop their fluency, solve problems, and answer reasoning questions. After this, we will move onto learning about length and

Relationships and Health Education

In RHE, we will be looking at 'Belonging to a community'. Within this, we will discuss what a community is, what it feels like to be a part of a group and how we can help our local community.

RE

In our religious education this half term we will be learning more about Hinduism. Within this, we will learn about what it means to be a Hindu in Britain today.

Geography

In our geography learning this term, we will be doing atlas work to locate countries of the world. We will look at different climate zones, physical features, and biomes.

History

As Historians, we will be learning about the Anglo-Saxons and their impact on Britain. We will add to our chronological skills, ask questions and analyse different sources.

PE

In PE this half term, we will be learning the skills of striking and fielding through various adapted games of rounders and tennis. During their swimming lessons, the children will perfect various strokes and refine their

Science

As scientists, the children will be defining solids, liquids, and gasses. As part of their learning, they will conduct multiple experiments to explore the properties of these states of matter.

Art/D&T

As Artists, we will be focussing on the work of Plymouth artist, Brian Pollard. The children will think about colour mixing and painting techniques to create their own seascape painting in his style.

Modern Foreign Languages (MFL)

For the topic of "La clase" (the classroom), the children will be introduced to twelve new nouns for key classroom objects and using these alongside "tengo" (I have), "en mi estuche" (in my pencil case), and "en mi

As musicians, the children are going to learn more about the theory of music, performing using their voice and learning more about the glockenspiels.

Computing

As users of technology, we will be programming virtual robot-turtles which shall draw repeating patterns that can be used to produce a decorative wrapping paper!
